12 OCT DEPART USA

13OCT ARRIVE ISTANBUL, TURKEY

On arrival at the Istanbul Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Check in and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. This is a group transfer for a specific flight (to be determined at a later date). Private transfers can be arranged for about 135 euros per 5 passenger SUV.

14OCT FULL DAY ISTANBUL CITY TOUR

(B)

After breakfast, depart for a full day tour of the city. Your first stop will be **Blue Mosque or Sultan Ahmed Mosque**, famous for its stunning blue tiles and six minarets, this mosque is one of Istanbul's most iconic landmarks. Visitors can admire its intricate interior and learn about its significance in Ottoman religious life.

Continue to Haggai St. Sophia, built by Emperor Constantius is 360 AD. St. Sophia was for many centuries the world's largest church and today is the fourth largest one after St. Paul's in London, St. Peter's in Rome and Duomo in Milan. Throughout its Byzantine history, St. Sophia served as the cathedral of the city

where emperors were crowned and victories celebrated. Today it is a grand Mosque.

Proceed to the underground cistern, an awe-inspiring ancient water storage system, this subterranean marvel is supported by 336 columns and features dim lighting that creates a mystical atmosphere. It was built during the Byzantine Empire to supply water to the city.

Lastly, make a stop at the hippodrome, once a grand chariot-racing arena. Today, it is home to significant monuments like the Egyptian Obelisk and the Serpent Column.

Break for Lunch (not included).

After lunch we will head to the **Spice Market**: Also known as the Egyptian Bazaar, this market is a sensory delight filled with the rich aromas of spices, herbs, teas, dried fruits, nuts, and sweets. Originally built to fund the New Mosque, the Spice Market is a historical landmark where visitors can explore the vibrant colors and smells while sampling traditional Turkish delights like lokum (sweet jelly candy) and baklava. This market provides an immersive experience in Istanbul's culinary delights, you will get a chance to taste authentic Turkish teas and Turkish delights. Don't forget to bring out your haggling skills.

After the tour, you will be transferred to your hotel for overnight and leisure. Both men and women are required to wear clothing that covers their shoulders and knees. Women should also cover their heads with a scarf.

15OCT TOPKAPI PALACE AND GRAND BAZAAR TOUR

After breakfast, depart for your day tour of the Topkapi palace and the Grand Bazaar.

Our day starts with a visit to the Topkapi Palace, a stunning historical complex that served as the primary residence of Ottoman sultans for nearly 400 years. The palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site, offers a fascinating glimpse into the opulence of the Ottoman Empire. Visitors can explore its grand courtyards, intricate rooms, and remarkable collections, including sacred relics, imperial treasures, and exquisite art. Highlights include the Harem, the Imperial Treasury, and the breathtaking views of the Bosphorus from the palace's terraces. A tour of Topkapi Palace unveils the rich history and luxurious lifestyle of the sultans who ruled over vast territories.

Break for Lunch (not included)

Today is a fascinating journey through one of the city's most iconic and historic marketplaces. Your second stop will be at the **Grand Bazaar**: One of the largest

and oldest covered markets in the world, the Grand Bazaar features over 4,000 shops spread across 61 streets. It's a bustling hub where visitors can find a variety of goods, including textiles, jewelry, antiques, leather goods, and ceramics. The maze-like structure offers a unique shopping experience, showcasing Ottoman architecture and the vibrant energy of Turkish commerce. This market provides an immersive experience in Istanbul's culture, history, making for an exciting and authentic tour. Don't forget to bring out your haggling skills.

After the tour, return to your hotel for leisure and overnight.

CANCELLATION:

LAND PENALTIES:

- More than 91 days prior to departure loss of non-refundable deposit
- Between 90-61 days prior to departure 75% of the tour price
- 60 days or less prior to departure 100% non-refundable

INSURANCE:

PASSPORT & VISA INFORMATION:

Passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from your scheduled return date.

II. <u>VISAS</u>

Important:

At the time of this quotation, US Citizens do not require a visa to enter Turkey or Greece however an ETIAS Visa waiver will be required for US passport holders to 22 European Countries (Greece included) <u>plus</u> Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway & Switzerland, Monaco, San Marino & Vatican City. The current tentative scheduled date for the launch of this requirement is for some time in 2025. For the **latest** information, please visit https://etias.com/.

The above information applies to US passport holders only. Please make sure that all destinations to be visited or transited are verified with the applicable consulate(s) for entry requirements prior to departure, together with requirements for anyone travelling on **non US passports**.
